SUMMARY:

- Responsible for the provision of rehabilitation programs to promote the physical, intellectual, emotional, psychosocial, and spiritual well being of facility residents.
- As a program supervisor for the Therapeutic Services Department, is responsible for the management of assigned human resources.
- Adheres to policies and procedures, and work routines.
- Ensures a safe and sanitary work environment.
- Works in partnership to improve the performance of individuals, teams and the organization in providing improved customer service for residents, guests and staff.
- Adheres to professional standards of practice.
- Responsible for the provision of individual and group rehabilitation programs based on the assessed needs of the current customer population. Works with the Interdisciplinary Therapeutic Services team to develop meaningful facility wide programs. Programs may include, but are not limited to the following:
 - Positioning, transfers, lifts, ambulating, physical functioning, cognitive functioning and activities of daily living
 - Facilitating referrals to appropriate community resources
 - Management of AADL benefits and equipment
 - Skin care management
 - Falls management
 - Pain management
 - Other therapeutic programs
- Documents care, programs, and interactions as required on the resident's health care record.
- Maintains an awareness of community resource/services and facilitates access to such services, as required by facility customers.
- Maintains statistical records as required by AB Health.
- Maintains equipment and supply inventory.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor degree in Physiotherapy is required.
- A minimum of two years work experience relevant to Continuing Care Services is required.
- Preference given to applicants with work experience related to cognitively impaired persons and their families.
- Demonstrates effective communication, problem solving and organizational skills.
- Ability to function as an effective team member with other Staff, Residents, Families and the Public.
