

- Chinook and Southwood Hospices promise to provide patients who are facing terminal illness with the best quality of alternative care.
- Chinook and Southwood Hospice Teams are dedicated and specialized professionals who provide comprehensive, specialized care that is focused on easing the physical, emotional and spiritual pain that often accompanies terminal illness.

Visitors

- Hospice has no set visiting hours; family and friends are welcome to visit their loved one 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Children are welcome, but must be under the supervision of an adult while visiting.
- Pets are welcome, but must be supervised at all times and can not stay over night.
- Cots are available for a family member who wishes to sleep in his/her loved one's room.
- A Guest Suite is available that can be rented by family members (on a nightly basis).
- The Hospices do not have cafeterias available; however, meals can be ordered and purchased by family members / visitors.
- Smoking is prohibited anywhere within or on Intercare property, including Hospice.

Hospice Services

Costs Associated with Hospice

- Accommodation fees (costs) for patients residing in hospice are covered by Alberta Health (AH).
- ▼ Each hospice patient is provided with a private room that is equipped with a telephone and television, at no charge to the patient.
- Additional costs will depend on a patient's needs and may include, for example, costs associated with medication and oxygen costs.

The Hospice Teams

The Hospice Teams consist of:

- Attending Physicians who provide care in collaboration with the hospice team and in consultation with palliative care physician consultants.
- Registered Nurses (RNs) and Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs) who focus on maintaining comfort, symptom and pain management.
- Care Aides who provide personal care and daily assistance.
- Social Workers who support families with personal, financial and community resources to enable the development of a support network and bereavement services.
- Spiritual Coordinators who offer spiritual support and direction.
- Trained Volunteers who provide friendly support, companionship, encouragement and assistance.
