



REQUIREMENTS FOR VISITATION AT INTERCARE SITES

1. Do not visit if you are sick or feeling unwell.
2. All visitors continue to be subject to screening and risk self-assessment on arrival at an Intercare site.
3. Requirement for proof of COVID-19 vaccination, or a negative PCR or rapid test taken within seventy-two (72) hours of visitation in lieu of COVID-19 vaccination, by visitors to our care homes remains unchanged.
4. All visitors must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and present their QR code confirming same upon arrival for visitation. In lieu of being fully vaccinated, a negative PCR or rapid test taken within seventy-two (72) hours of visitation will be accepted.
5. Any visitor – regardless of whether they are fully vaccinated – who has had a close contact with anyone who is COVID-19 positive – must not visit for a minimum of fourteen (14) days.
6. Masks must be worn by visitors at all times while on site (including while visiting in a hospice patient's or resident's room) and other personal protective equipment (PPE) may be required as directed by Intercare staff.
7. Visitation may be changed without notice based on changes to visitation guidelines in continuing care issued by Alberta's Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) and/or as deemed necessary by Intercare for the safety and well-being of our patients, residents and staff. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience such changes in visitation and/or site access may cause, when and if they occur.

Thank you for your continued cooperation, support and understanding, as we work together with our patients, residents, family members and staff, to manage visitation within our care homes.
